- These **subject charges** are for goods and services, consumable course costs, i.e. take home materials which the student “consumes” during class time. These items may include food, paint or be the cost of a class trip. These are compulsory charges.
- A sum of money is available through the JR McKenzie Youth Foundation for parents/caregivers to provide financial assistance towards uniform costs for families. Application forms are available at the beginning of the year at the main office and must be completed and returned to school before 1 March. **Please note:** that decisions are not made by the school and there is no guarantee your application will be successful. The funds, when allocated, are paid to the school. Successful recipients advised around the beginning of July.
- Weekly or fortnightly Automatic payments may also be set up with the school Finance Department to meet subject charge costs.
- **NOTE: Computer printing costs are not included in these subject charges and must be purchased from the Finance Dept as the student requires.**
