

COPYRIGHT PROCEDURES

APRA: Music Performance Licence

Covers music performance, e.g.

- concerts on school premises by students or others
- school groups at multi-school festivals
- discos and socials at school
- aerobics sessions at school

Does not cover performances

- of “grand rights” musicals e.g. Jesus Christ Superstar, Les Miserables
- of music in a dramatic context (i.e. added to a dramatic show) where the show is advertised in the public press and run for a profit

AMCOS: Print Music Licence

Allows the school to copy print music purchased by the school for the educational purposes of students of the school (i.e. for use in rehearsal or performances by bands/orchestras, choirs or other ensembles).

CLL: Printed Copyright Text Licences

Permits the school to copy

- up to 10% of one chapter of a work
- up to 15 pages of all or part of a single work in a collection of works
- one or part of one article from a periodical publication or additional articles if they are on the same subject
- a complete work if the work is unavailable in sufficient quantity within a reasonable time at a normal price (subject to prior written approval)
- an artistic work (such as an illustration) published in conjunction with another work and produced as part of a reproduction of that work

Copies can be made for each student and teacher involved in the educational course each year plus a 10% margin for spare copies.

Some materials (including printed music, overseas newspaper articles, loose maps, photographs, etc) may not be copied under the licence. Copying of this material must be in accordance with the Copyright Act or with approval from the copyright owner.

Screenrights

This covers the copying of television programmes including all documentaries, news programmes, educational programming and general programming shown on both cable and free to air.

There are no limits in the licence as to the amount of a single programme the school may copy nor is there a limit on the number of copies the school may make. Entire programmes or excerpts of programmes may be copied and multiple copies of a programme may be made. Copies of separate programmes may also be compiled onto one tape for convenience sake.
