

Spotswood College Uniform – Years 9 - 12



Our uniform is the face of our school. We expect high standards of compliance with our uniform regulations. We appreciate the support of parents/caregivers to ensure that our students look neat and tidy at all times including travelling to and from school.

All uniform is purchased through the school Uniform Shop on school grounds.

Please remind students that all uniform items should be named, especially shoes and jerseys.

Girls

- Navy school regulation inverted pleat skirt / Navy school regulation shorts
- Navy school regulation trousers (optional)
- Black / Navy blue opaque tights
- Short sleeve dark green polo with gold and navy trim
- Only navy blue/black thermal (long or short sleeved) may be worn under the polo shirt
- Dark green V-neck woollen jersey with school motif
- All black sandals - must be plain in style and worn with a heel strap. Absolutely no rubber jandals
- All black shoes
- Black / Navy blue ankle socks (with shoes)
- School regulation jacket only

Boys

- Navy school regulation shorts
- Navy school regulation trousers (optional)
- Short sleeve dark green polo with gold and navy trim
- Navy blue/black thermal (long or short sleeved) may be worn under the polo shirt
- Dark green V-neck woollen jersey with school motif
- All black flat sole sandals - must be plain in style and worn with a heel strap. Absolutely no rubber jandals
- All black shoes
- Black / Navy blue ankle socks (with shoes)
- School regulation jacket only

Scarves / Hats / Caps / Hoodie

- A navy scarf, navy beanie or navy cap with School Crest may be purchased from the school
- Students who are part of a Spotswood College Sports team or Cultural group can wear the blue Spotswood College hoodie.

Year 9: School green sports shorts and regulation PE shirt

Hairstyle

- Must be neat and appropriate for school setting; Hair colour must be a natural colour.
- Boys must be clean shaven

Jewellery

- a wristwatch is allowed
- piercings to have clear studs only
- rings may be worn so long as they are not a health and safety risk to self or others
- jewellery is worn at one's own risk
- taonga and similar items may be worn under the polo shirt
